

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

FAST TRACK:

The applicant **HAS** a sponsor. The applicant and the sponsor need to attend the meeting at which the application is presented. The sponsor needs to be knowledgeable about the applicant, e.g. how long the applicant has been known by the sponsor, in what capacity and other additional information as appropriate and be able to speak to these. The application is read and the applicant's name will be posted. The application will be acted on at the next regular meeting of the club where the applicant is present. Dues are based upon the calendar year: full dues January 1st through June 30th; half dues from July 1st through December 31st.

SLOW TRACK:

The applicant **DOES NOT** have a sponsor. The applicant comes to a meeting with the application. The application is read and the applicants name posted. The applicant needs to attend a total of three regular meetings. This will allow time for said applicant to meet other club members, come to matches, or attend a work day. Hopefully by the time of the third meeting, the applicant will have found a sponsor, someone who can then attest to the applicant's character. The application will be acted upon at the third meeting. Dues are based on the calendar year: full dues January 1st through June 30th; half dues from July 1st through December 31st.

NOTE:

If an applicant works nights or lives out of the area and does not have a sponsor, the application will need to go the slow track route and the applicant will need to attend at least one work day **AND** match day to fulfill application requirements of two of the three required meetings and to meet club members in order to find a sponsor who can attest to the applicants character. Applicant and sponsor need to be present when the application is acted upon.
