

LCRC Wednesday Night .22 Fun Shoots

[Wednesday Night .22 Fun Shoots](#) will begin the first week of November -- November 2 through early April.

Weather permitting, .22 Fun Shoots take place inside the 50-foot range every Wednesday night. Shooting starts at 7 p.m. and runs until around 9 p.m. This is an open, sanctioned club shoot. Members, guests, and non-members are welcome. Young shooters, accompanied and supervised by an adult, are encouraged and will usually be allowed to shoot free of charge, depending on age and skill level. Young shooters are eligible for the cash prize.

The match cost is \$6 per shooter for 10 matches / targets. Half of the cost goes to the club, and half to prizes. An optional \$1 per shooter "Throw-it-in-the-Pot" / "Winner-Take-All Match" rounds out the evening.

Any .22 Rimfire rifle, shorts, longs, or long rifle is permitted, but no magnums or Stingers please. Any sights are allowed, though a scope is strongly recommended. No slings. All shooting is done off-hand, standing on your hind feet with no other part of your body leaning, resting, or otherwise touching any external surface, although allowances are made for young shooters.

We will be shooting 10 matches, each at a different novelty target. Each match will be scored and paid separately. Depending on the number of shooters/money collected, we pay First, Second, and sometimes more places. Prizes run from 50 cents to \$3. There is also the final and optional \$1 "Winner-Take-All Match" – this can run over \$20 when there are a lot of shooters. About 50 rounds are needed for the shoot.

Please try to arrive at least 10-15 minutes early so that shooting can start at 7 p.m. Unpack rifles in the main club house, make sure rifles are unloaded and the action is open, and bring rifle and ammo only to the back indoor range as the space tends to get crowded on busy nights. There are rifle racks in the range.
